### **Cultural Rebound**

Bouncing back from a setback is a life learning experience. It is quite difficult to recover from an illness, a heartbreak or a major disappointment. Oftentimes, it requires a great deal of patience, fortitude and energy to exert the effort needed to return to a reasonable state of acceptance of what life brings us. Throughout the Covid pandemic, many of us have learned how to cope with challenges and how to temper our expectations in order to control our disappointments for the things we have been missing in our lives.

Having not been able to participate in a CFU Junior Tamburitza Festival for the past two years has been problematic for many young tamburitzans who had enjoyed previous years of attending this yearly musical festival. These children and young adults have been remembering the great times they had in years past and the excitement and fun they shared. Many have expressed their disappointment of missing out on these festivals with family, friends and other tamburitzans who felt the same tug of sadness and emptiness when the Fourth of July weekend occurred in 2020 and 2021.

For those young members who had never experienced a CFU Junior Tamburitza Festival but, rather, just newly involved in a junior tamburitza ensemble and who were just beginning to learn to play a tambura, to sing Croatian melodies and to dance kolos, the abrupt discontinuation of these lessons prompted even greater concerns for parents and instructors. Would the children return to these ensembles once pandemic restrictions were lifted? Would

they still have an interest in attending these group lessons? Would they ever enjoy the opportunity to take part in a CFU Festival? Those questions, unfortunately, still remain unanswered for a number of CFU junior tamburitza ensembles.

Thankfully, the 2022 CFU Junior Tamburitza Festival is on schedule for July 1-2-3 at Baltimore, Maryland. Several hundred junior tamburitzans are poised to perform. The impetus to entertain and to share their musical talents with fellow tamburitzans from a dozen other cities across the continent is nearly at a fever pitch as the first weekend in July draws near. When the festival pageantry finally takes place, the familiar feelings of pride, personal accomplishment and excitement will no doubt energize these young tamburitzans to celebrate the Festival's return and reignite their enthusiasm for future involvement.

In the months ahead, we are confident more young CFU budding musicians, singers and dancers will discover the joys of being a CFU junior tamburitzan. The benefits of learning a musical instrument along with the music and lyrics of Croatian songs, gaining coordination as a dancer, experiencing the thrills of performing and initiating lifelong friendships are all part of the tamburitza package.

Where do we go from here? The future is yet to unfold, but if past fraternal involvement offers a glimpse, thanks to many CFU members, there are now generations of families who have junior tamburitzans, adult tamburitzans and budding young tamburitzans in their lineage who share this unique musical bond. We are encouraged this progression is indicative that many more CFU tamburitzans will emerge to carry on the legacy of our musical culture and ancestry. *Živili Naši Tamburaši!*



BI. Kardinal Aloysius Stepinac Documentary Screening held at St. Nicholas RC Croatian Church located in Millvale, Pennsylvania.

On Monday, June 13, 2022, we were pleased to take part in the Pittsburgh area screening of the documentary film produced and directed by Višnja Starešina, a Croatian journalist and author. Prior to the screening at the St. Nicholas Croatian worship site of the Shrines of Pittsburgh parish, our officers and staff welcomed Ms. Starešina and H.E. Pjer Šimunović, Croatian Ambassador to the United States, to the home office facility of the Croatian Fraternal Union of America.



After a tour of our office and Bernard M. Luketich Croatian Cultural Museum, we sat down for a brief interview with our guests. Our Executive Board Members and Co-editors of **Zajedničar**, Lorraine Turkall and Ivan Begg, participated in the exchange. Some of the more interesting highlights of the exchange are contained in the following paragraphs.

Ms. Starešina was motivated to tell the story of Bl. Kardinal Stepinac as she believed that his legacy is universal. Recognizing that he was written about extensively in present day Croatia, she wanted to tell his story to the world through the documentary.

The Cardinal was beatified by His Holiness Pope John Paul II on October 3, 1998 in recognition of the life in service of Christ that he led. Bl. Kardinal Stepinac was chosen for the position of Archbishop of Zagreb by his predecessor Archbishop Anton Bauer after only serving as a priest for a little more than three years. The cardinal prayed at that time that he not be elevated, however relented, and chose the motto of, "In te, Domine, spe ravi," which translates to "In you, Lord, I place my trust."

During World War II, he was an outspoken defender of human rights and vocal critic of Fascism. This made him an enemy of the state during the war years of 1941-1945; however, the Catholic Church members thronged to his sermons in Zagreb which presented a problem to his detractors. He was considered a "Hero" among Croatian Catholics and as well as large numbers of Jews who he helped evade capture and escape from death at the hands of the Nazis.

After the end of WWII, the victorious Partisans proved to be no better in their attitude toward Bl. Cardinal Stepinac and he was first placed in Lepoglava prison and later released to house arrest in his native village of Krašić, Croatia.

An outpouring of support for the Cardinal came from basically around the world, including the Catholic Church in the United States where a newly established Catholic High School in White Plains, New York, was named Archbishop Stepinac High School, in recognition of the values of love, sacrifice, bravery and humility that he exhibited throughout his lifetime.

Named a Cardinal in November of 1952, Bl. Kardinal Stepinac would not travel to the Vatican to receive his red hat as he knew the Government of Yugoslavia would not permit him to return to his Catholic on page 11)

he CFU operates as a fraternal society with a lodge system. Activities and governance take place on a national, regional and local level. As a CFU member, you are valued on all of these levels. Local lodges provide the most "hands-on" way for a member to participate in the Society on a regular basis. CFU lodges truly follow the motto of "All for One - One for All" and value their members and their participation.

CFU is required to report local lodge fraternal data annually to the American Fraternal Alliance (AFA). The data is used by the AFA to increase the public's awareness of benevolent activities carried on by fraternal benefit societies.

Local lodge data is also used to demonstrate to legislators, insurance departments and other public officials the impact of fraternal efforts. It is very important for CFU to portray an accurate picture of the good work that the members and lodges take part in.

We are pleased to report that in the Year 2021, CFU had 206 active lodges and approximately the same number of nests in its fraternal ranks.

During 2021, the Croatian Fraternal Union of America donated \$701,451 to charitable causes and performed 34,842 hours of volunteer service for Fraternal Social/Fellowship Activities.

There were also 25,549 hours of work and financial disbursements of \$114,275 for Local Community Services. These numbers show the positive work of our Society. We are very proud of the work of our lodges/nests, specifically because these activities took place during a pandemic with many limitations.

As a fraternal society, we are very proud of the work and effort our members and lodges put forth! We extend sincere gratitude to all participants that made these events successful.

## MINUTES

#### **EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING** WEDNESDAY, APRIL 20, 2022

National President Pazo called the Meeting of the Executive Board to order at 10:05 a.m. with customary Fraternal Greetings.

In attendance were National President Pazo, National Vice President/Member Services Bertović and National Secretary/Treasurer Luketich-Sikaras. Minutes of the Wednesday, March 16, 2022 meeting of the Executive Board were read and officially approved.

President Pazo began the meeting with a review of the 77th CFU National Basketball Tournament which took place April 1-3, 2022 and was hosted by Holy Cross Lodge 320 of Duquesne, PA. This first post pandemic basketball tournament was modified as a competition of the men's open division only. The team from Lodge 126 of Farrell was the tournament champion. We should be able to return to a full tournament in 2023.

President Pazo noted that the 86th National Bowling Tournament will take place in Merrillville, IN the weekend of May 13-15, 2022 hosted by Croatian Sons Lodge 170.

President Pazo confirmed that the contract for Home Office HVAC services has been signed with a new HVAC services provider (Gunning) and the term is from April 1, 2022 - March 31, 2023.

President Pazo then presented a proposed agenda for the upcoming annual meeting of the CFU National Board which will be held May 3-5 with the annual meeting of the Board of Trustees beginning Monday, May 2nd. Blaženi Kardinal Alojzije Stepinac, dokumentarna projekcija održana je u hrvatskoj crkvi Sv. Nikole smještenoj u gradu Millvaleu nadomak Pittsburgha u Pennsylvaniji.

Naime, u ponedjeljak, 13. lipnja 2022. sa zadovoljstvom smo ovdje na području Pittsburgha prisustvovali na projekciji dokumentarnog filma u produkciji i režiji Višnje Starešine, hrvatske novinarke i autorice. Uoči projekcije u hrvatskoj crkvi Sv. Nikoli u Millvalle, naši odbornici i osoblje pozdravili su gospođu Starešinu i g. Pjera Šimunovića, hrvatskog veleposlanika u Sjedinjenim Američkim Državama, u glavnom uredu Hrvatske bratske zajednice Amerike. Nakon obilaska našeg ureda i hrvatskog kulturnog muzeja Bernard M. Luketich sjeli smo na kratki razgovor s našim gostima. U razmjeni su sudjelovali članovi našeg Izvršnog odbora te suurednici Zajedničara, Lorraine Turkall i Ivan Begg. Gospođa Starešina bila je motivirana ispričati priču o blaženom Kardinalu Stepincu jer je vjerovala da je njegova ostavština univerzalna. Prepoznavši da se o njemu intenzivno pisalo u današnjoj Hrvatskoj, željela je kroz dokumentarac ispričati njegovu priču svijetu. Kardinala je blaženim proglasio Njegova Svetost Papa Ivan Pavao II. 3. listopada 1998. u znak priznanja Kristovu životu u službi koji je vodio. Blaženog Kardinala Stepinca na mjesto zagrebačkog nadbiskupa izabrao je njegov prethodnik nadbiskup Anton Bauer nakon što je tek nešto više od tri godine bio svećenik. Kardinal je tada molio da ne bude uzdignut koliko god popustio i odabrao moto "In te, Domine, spe ravi" što u prijevodu znači "U tebe, Gospodine, polažem svoje povjerenje".

Tijekom Drugog svjetskog rata bio je otvoreni branitelj ljudskih prava i glasni kritičar fašizma. To ga je učinilo neprijateljem države tijekom ratnih godina 1941.-1945.; međutim, članovi Katoličke crkve u velikom su broju posjećivali njegove propovijedi u Zagrebu koje su predstavljale problem njegovim klevetnicima. Smatran je "herojem" među hrvatskim katolicima, kao i velikim brojem Židova kojima je pomogao izbjeći zarobljavanje i od smrti od strane nacista.

Nakon završetka Drugog svjetskog rata pobjednički partizani pokazali su se ništa boljima u odnosu prema blaženju kardinalu Stepincu te je prvo smješten u lepoglavski zatvor, a kasnije pušten u kućni pritvor u rodnom selu Krašiću u Hrvatskoj.

Ogromne podrške kardinalu došle su u osnovi iz cijelog svijeta, uključujući Katoličku crkvu u Sjedinjenim Državama gdje je novoosnovana Katolička srednja škola u White Plaines, u New Yorku dobila ime, nadbiskup Stepinac Srednja škola u znak priznanja vrijednostima ljubavi, žrtve, hrabrosti i poniznosti koje je izlagao tijekom svog života.

Imenovan kardinalom u studenom 1952., blaženi Kardinal Stepinac nije htio otputovati u Vatikan kako bi dobio crveni šešir jer je znao da mu Vlada Jugoslavije neće dopustiti povratak svojim katoličkim vjernicima u Hrvatskoj. Kao odgovor i u odnosu na ovaj život pobožnosti, mnogi ugledni novinari tog vremena pisali su članke o njemu. I na 7. strani)

#### KAKO SE RIJEŠITI MRAVA?

#### Prirodni načini za borbu!

U ovim toplim vremenima u dvorištima i kućama neizbježna je pojava kukaca. Neki od njih lako se udomaće, a ako u svom domu primijetite mrava znajte da uvijek dolaze u velikom broju.

Mravi u domove ulaze kroz sitne otvore i pukotine, a privlače ih ostaci hrane, posebice one koja sadrži puno šećera. Mrave ćete najčešće pronaći u kuhinji, ali i na vlažnim mjestima poput kupaonica, u podovima ili stropovima. Nazivaju se štetočinama jer se kreću u kolonijama koje mogu brojati više od tisuću jedinki te ih se izrazito teško riješiti jer mravinjake grade na mjestima koje je teško pronaći, a samim time i ukloniti.

Kako biste se riješili mrava, potrebno je riješiti se cijele kolonije. Kupovna sredstva sadrže otrovne sastojke te nisu najsigurnija opcija, posebice ako imate malo dijete ili kućne ljubimce. Donosimo vam neke od prirodnih načina za borbu protiv mrava u vašem domu.

**Soda bikarbona** - Sodu bikarbonu pomiješajte sa šećerom u prahu te pospite po mjestima gdje ste primijetili mrave ili gdje bi se potencijalno mogli pojaviti.

Ocat - Bijeli ocat jedno je od najpoznatijih prirodnih sredstava za uklanjanje mrava. Pomiješajte jednaku količinu octa i vode u bocu s raspršivačem te poprskajte na površine na kojima ste vidjeli mrave.

**Sol** - Nekoliko žlica kuhinjske soli pomiješajte s kipućom vodom i pustite da se tekućina ohladi. Prelijte ju u bocu s raspršivačem te pošpricajte sve površine na kojima se mravi skupljaju.

Kava - Intenzivan miris mljevene kave odbija mrave. Pospite ju na mjesta gdje se mravi skupljaju i velika je vjerojatnost da ih tamo više nećete vidjeti

**Limun** - Iscijeđen limunov sok stavite na mjesta iz kojih ste primijetili da mravi izlaze. Kao i s kavom, mrave odbija miris citrusa te će ova mjesta zasigurno izbjegavati.

Cimet - Miris cimeta također odbija kukce te je ovo jednostavan trik za sprječavanje ulaska mrava u vaš dom. Pospite cimet na željena mjesta ili napravite liniju na mjestu gdje vam mravi ulaze u dom. Ovaj trik možete koristiti i kako biste zaštitili odjeću od moljaca tako da u vrećicu stavite štapić cimeta i objesite ga u ormar. Također, ovo vrijedi i za većinu drugih začina koje imate u svojim kuhinjskim ormarićima, primjerice kurkumu i papar.

**Deterdžent** - Prokuhajte vodu i dodajte joj nekoliko kapi kuhinjskog deterdženta te pošpricajte mjesta na kojima ste vidjeli mrave.

Kreda - Kalcijev karbonat odbija mrave. Kredom nacrtajte liniju i mravi ju neće htjeti prijeći!

Nakon primjenjivanja nekih od ovih savjeta ne perite tretirane površine najmanje dva dana te po potrebi ponovite postupak jednom ili više puta. Sretno!

- 1 tsp. cinnamon
- 1 12-oz. pkg. chocolate chips

Add the remaining dry ingredients to the mixture and then stir in the chocolate chips. Combine well and turn into a well-greased jellyroll sheet pan (10x15x1 inches).

Bake at 325 degrees for 20-25 minutes until toothpick in center comes out clean.

Powdered sugar

Mix hot coffee, a little at a time, with some powdered sugar to make a glaze consistency. Glaze top of cake while cake is still warm. Cool and cut into bars.

#### Peanut Butter Oatmeal Cookies

- 1 jar (12 oz.) peanut butter 1/2 c. butter, softened
- 1 c. plus 2 Tbsp. brown sugar
- 1 c. pius 2 rosp. brown sug 1 c. sugar
- 3 eggs
- 2 tsp. baking soda
- 3/4 tsp. vanilla extract
- 3/4 tsp. corn syrup
- 4 1/2 c. quick-cooking oats
- 1 c. chocolate chips
- 1/2 c. English toffee bits or almond brickle chips

Cream peanut butter, butter, brown sugar; add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition.

Beat in baking soda, vanilla, corn syrup; stir in oats, chips, toffee bits.

Drop by rounded tablespoonfuls 2 inches apart onto a greased baking sheet. Bake at 350° for 10-12 minutes, or until lightly browned. Cool for 1 minute before removing from sheet.




